FURNITURE SPECIFICATIONS

Woodtech offers a range of furniture options that include pieces which allow reconfiguration by omitting modesty and end panels. The edge detail on reconfigurable desks and freestanding credenzas is on the leading edging only. When specifying "U" shape or "L" shaped workstations, the bridge return or credenza will not have edge detail.

A large range of pedestals and filing options are available. All peds have full extension drawer slides and locks are standard with the exception of hinged door storage.

With fixed furniture series to select and interchange from, Woodtech offers competitive pricing for budget considerations, ranging from basic to traditional as well as personalized high quality styling. VENEER SPECIFICATIONS

Woodtech uses plain sliced architectural grade "A" veneers. All veneers are hand selected. Veneer faces are center-balanced on tops, sequence-matched on door and drawer faces as standard. Specialty veneers such as Anigre, Birdseye Maple, Curly Maple or Makore are available upon request.

Solid hardwood edging is placed on any exterior edge ranging from 1/8” to 4” in thickness. All hardwood has been monitored for correct moisture content and is defect-free.

- **Scuff Sealer:** We scuff the surfaces again to prepare the casegood surfaces for the lacquer.
- **Primary Topcoat:** Using the airless spray guns and heat pumps, we apply a post-catalyzed vinyl-based lacquer film. This provides elasticity to the finish which, in turn, prevents chipping and flaking of the finish.
- **Scuff Topcoat:** We spray the entire case again with post-catalyzed, vinyl-based lacquer film to provide maximum protection of the veneer and provide build-up. We use a 35%-45% sheen on all topcoats for maximum durability.
- **Flash Dry:** We place a freshly top coated piece under a canopy to “flash dry” the case as an extra precaution to protect the case from dust and particle adhesion.

HARDWARE SPECIFICATIONS

Woodtech offers the highest quality hardware available. Accuride suspension with steel ball bearings and Salice hinges for all doors are standard. File and box drawers are constructed of maple with steel powder-coated file bars that will not bend under the weight of the files

FURNITURE CARE

- For general daily care, we recommend that you use a dampened cloth with clean water.
- To remove dirt stuck on surfaces, use a mild soap and water solution, and wipe off with clean water afterward to remove the soap.
- To add shine to your furniture, polish with lemon oil. However, lemon oil is not recommended for daily use. We do not recommend waxing or rubbing the surface with any type of abrasive.
- Ink marks can be easily removed by rubbing the stained area with a pencil eraser.
